Missions: Do you have beautiful feet?

Take a look at your feet. How beautiful are they? I am not asking if you have a pair of well-pedicured feet, but rather, whether these feet have brought good news to the nations. Isaiah 52:7 says, *"How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"*

Some of the challenges these leaders faced were tremendous, yet our pastors were able to help

them. I was wowed by the wise counsel our pastors gave. I was also amazed by the passion with which our pastors counseled and taught. They gave everything they had. At times, when I was asked to share my ministry experience, I

gladly did so. It was humbling because these leaders were much older and more experienced than me. Through our ministry, God touched the people's lives, encouraging their hearts, and renewing their vision and hope. Many who had come with burdened hearts were beaming by the end of the training. I could see that their countenance had brightened.

They were going back to their churches with hope in their spirit and tools in their hands, tools that they could use to plow their harvest field.

Never underestimate the ministry and work we do. Never underestimate the importance of your prayers for our missions teams. When you receive information of various teams or pastors ministering in the nations, do remember to pray for them. **Even before you reach the nations on your feet, you can reach them on your knees!**

Two thousand years ago, Jesus cried out for labourers. Today, He is still calling out. Where are the labourers? Stop looking around. They are you and me! **Make this year's Mission Convention a really special one where you hear, respond and make a commitment to His call to give, pray and go.**
